

**I-LYA Toledo Deep Water Race**  
**August 5<sup>th</sup> 2010**  
**Sailing Instructions**

**1. Rules**

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing and the Notice of Race.
- 1.2 If there is any conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race these Sailing Instructions will prevail.
- 1.3 A boat that retires from the race, for any reason, shall report her action as soon as possible to the Race Committee at Put In Bay on channel 71 or in person to the Race Committee.
- 1.4 Postponement shall be when “AP” flag is flown on the flagpole at NCYC or on the committee boat.

**2. The Start**

The starting line shall be between the NCYC West Mark and the Orange Flag on the Committee Boat.

**3. The Course**

The course shall be to the finish line leaving Rattlesnake Island to starboard and Middle Bass Island to port. The course length is 27.9 nm.

**4. The Finish Line**

The finish line will be on the north shore of South Bass Island at the Anchorage with an Orange buoy offshore and the flagpole on land. Leave the Orange buoy offshore to Port and the other Orange buoy close to shore to Starboard. Do not re-cross the Finish Line.

**5. The Time of Starts**

The warning gun for the Jam will be at 9:55 AM with a White Flag.  
The start for the Jam Class will be.....10:00 AM  
That will be the warning gun for PHRF with a Purple Flag.  
The start of the PHRF Class will be.....10:05 AM

**6. There will be no skippers meeting**

**7. Required Equipment**

All classes shall carry U. S. Coast Guard required safety equipment.  
A blue pennant must be flown from the backstay.

**8. Radio Communication**

The Race Committee will be on channel 71.  
Docking information will be on channel 72 or call 614-323-3634.
