

North Cape Yacht Club Junior Sail Camp Schedule 2010

Week 1 – June 14 - 18

Beginner Opti's- This is an introduction to sailing class. The student will learn about the parts of the boat, how to rig the boat and proper on the water maneuvers.

Beginner CFJ's- This class is designed for the sailor who has outgrown the optimist. The course introduces the sailor to the CFJ (a two person boat) and works on basic skills.

Week 2 – June 21 – 25

Advanced Opti- This class is designed for the experienced Optimist sailor who is interested in building boat handling skills and racing tactics.

Advanced CFJ's - This class is designed for the advanced CFJ sailor who is interested in beginning to race competitively. Advanced boat handling and spinnaker work will be emphasized.

Week 3 – June30 – July 2 (3 day camp)

Beginner Opti's- The student will learn about the parts of the boat, how to rig the boat and proper on the water maneuvers.

Beginner CFJ's- This class is designed for the sailor who has outgrown the optimist. The course introduces the sailor to the CFJ (a two person boat) and works on basic skills.

Week 4 – July 6 – 9 (4 day camp due to holiday)

Opti and CFJ's - Open to all levels of sailors.

Our coaching staff will be increased to ensure that all skill levels are attended to.

Week 5 - July 12 – 16

Beginner and Intermediate - Opti & CFJ's

-Beginning students will learn about the parts of the boat, how to rig the boat and proper on the water maneuvers.

-Intermediate students will learn and refine on the sailing skills including: up-wind sailing and tacking, down-wind sailing and jibing, capsizing and recovery.

Week 6 - August 2-6

Intermediate and Advanced - Opti & CFJ's

- This class is designed for the opti sailors who are comfortable sailing by themselves and would like to fine-tune their skills. Advanced optis are geared for the experienced sailor who is interested in building boat handling skills and racing tactics.

-This class is designed for the intermediate and advanced CFJ sailor who is interested in beginning to race competitively. Advanced boat handling and spinnaker work will be emphasized.

Week 7 - August 9-13

Advanced Opti- This class is designed for the experienced Optimist sailor who is interested in building boat handling skills and racing tactics. Prerequisite: Intermediate Opti.

Advanced CFJ's - This class is designed for the advanced CFJ sailor who is interested in beginning to race competitively. Advanced boat handling and spinnaker work will be emphasized.
