Sailor's Ethics and Code of Conduct

1. Be cooperative, supportive, and respectful of all other people.
2. Participate in daily activities.
3. Understand and obey the sailing "Rules of the Road."
4. Be gracious in success, failure, victory, and defeat.
5. Remember that your actions, both on and off the water, reflect upon you and the NCYC Sailing Program.

Rules and Safety Procedures

1. Arrive on time with equipment ready to go.
2. All children must obey the instructor at all times.
3. Stay with your class until dismissed by your instructor.
4. Life jackets **MUST** be worn and zipped at all times while in the dock area, launching area, or on the water.
5. Sailing footwear must be worn at all times.
6. Sunglasses, hats, sunscreen and drinking water are recommended.
7. Proper clothing (shoes and shirts) are required in the club facilities.
8. No wet clothing or wet sandy shoes in the club.
9. Pick up any trash you see.
10. Please keep our club and grounds clean.
