

PARENT OF THE DAY GUIDELINES

Parent of the Day (POD) was started to insure an extra level of safety for the kids and the instructors. It is also a great way to introduce the parents to the sailing experience at NCYC. If it's your first time as a POD the instructors will help you get started. It's a very fun and enjoyable day at the club. We hope you have an enjoyable learning experience with all the kids.

In order to provide safe on the water instruction, we have developed a few rules that we must insist all of our children obey.

1. Life Jackets with attached whistles are worn at all times when around the water, in the boats, launching, area or landing area.
2. All the children must obey the instructors at all times.
3. Children must remain in the designated areas of the club facilities.

Some of the duties of the day are as follows:

- Collect lunches at the beginning of the day and placing them in the walk in cooler.
- Supervise the lunch hour.
- Supervision of children who are not participating in activities for whatever reason i.e. Restroom patrol, sick room help.
- Assisting junior instructors in launching boats from the beach and/or from the ramp.
- Assisting in hauling boats out of the water.
- Monitor a hand held VHF radio.
